Year End 2008 by Janet Haley

While 2008 was not a good year for the stock markets and our endowment funds, Hendricks County Community Foundation has some bright spots to celebrate. We received over \$1 million in contributions, created 16 new funds and awarded nearly \$800,000 in grants to nonprofit organizations and projects as well as scholarships to students. A complete listing of 2008 grants can be found at the end of this article.

Nearly one-third of these grant dollars were generated through the Community Foundation's involvement in three large projects in the county—the Bell Tower at Plainfield High School, the Plainfield Youth Athletic Complex, and program support for Hendricks College Network. Each of these projects have a non-endowed fund at the Community Foundation. The fund allows the project to have a 501(c)(3) designation and the Community Foundation provides administrative support to these projects by processing donations, sending acknowledgement letters and paying bills.

Renea Whicker of the Plainfield Youth Athletic Complex Fund Raising Committee shared, "The ability to provide our community's youth with a safe, state-of-the-art athletic facility is priceless."

While we are very proud of these successes in 2008, we are also very aware of the stress and tension the downturn in the economy is having on our donors. The Community Foundation has seen about a 12% decrease in our Annual Support gifts which will have a significant impact on our operating budget. We are striving to work more frugally and efficiently than ever before.

Endowment funds at the Community Foundation are pooled together and invested in a well-diversified portfolio of equity and fixed income securities. During 2008, the total portfolio was down -28.5% compared to the S&P 500 at -37%, Russell 1000 at -37.6%, MSCI EAFE at -43.38% and Lehman U.S. Aggregate Bond at 5.24%. While this negative return is quite shocking, the Finance Committee and our

investment managers believe that our commitment to the long-term investment strategy is appropriate for our endowment funds. While these investments have seen further decline in early 2009, we are hopeful that economic conditions will improve in the near future.

Due to the negative return incurred in 2008, almost all of the endowment funds at the Community Foundation are in a situation where the Ending Fund Balance is less than the Principal Fund Balance (or cumulative gifts to the fund since inception). According to the Community Foundation's current spending policy for endowment funds, no grants can be made from a fund in this situation. Therefore, no grants will be allowed from endowment funds during 2009. This was a very difficult decision for the Board of Directors to make. Board President Dan Whipple states, "The Board feels that preserving the Principal Fund Balance is our fiduciary responsibility and we take this role very seriously."

Give & You Shall Receive

Yes, that's the way it works. With a Hendricks County Community Foundation (HCCF) gift annuity, you not only receive the satisfaction of helping to further philanthropy in Hendricks County, but the annuity pays you for the rest of your life.

Example: John & Mary Jones are in their late 70s. They give \$100,000 to a Hendricks County Community Foundation gift annuity for both of them. Assuming a gift annuity rate of 6.0%, they will receive \$6,000 every year for the rest of their lives. Even after one of them dies, the remaining spouse will continue to receive the same payment amount. On top of this, the Joneses will receive a charitable income tax deduction, and a substantial portion of their payments will be tax-free. Current one-year certificate of deposit rates are currently less than 3%.

Why does the Hendricks County Community Foundation offer gift annuities? Many of our friends want to give more to the community through the Community Foundation, but live on fixed incomes and can't afford to donate income-producing assets. With our gift annuity program, they can make a significant gift and still retain lifetime income. In some cases, they can even increase their annual cash flow.

Example: Jane Smith is 80 years old and has common stock in a company that pays her a dividend of 2% per year. This means that \$100,000 worth of stock provides Jane with quarterly



checks of only \$500 (or \$2,000 annually). Jane can transfer this stock to the Community Foundation for a charitable gift annuity. Assuming a gift annuity rate of 7.1%, she could receive \$1,775 each quarter (or \$7,100 annually). And her payments are secured by all the assets of Hendricks County Community Foundation. In these uncertain economic times, the fixed payment of a gift annuity can bring Jane peace of mind and a substantial increase to her current income.

Fixed payments, income tax deduction for those who itemize, possible reduction of estate taxes and other benefits make a HCCF gift annuity a prudent option for many of our older friends.

In fact, some savvy donors obtain additional annuities as they get older because of the higher payment rates.

There's something else our gift annuity donors receive: membership in the HCCF Heritage Society. This special group of forward-thinking people is collaborating with us in planning for the future. Their gift annuities and other planned gifts assure us that vital resources are in the pipeline to help HCCF fulfill its mission to the next generation.
