Hendricks County Community Foundation Approves New Executive Director

Hendricks County – At the August Board of Director’s meeting of the Hendricks County Community Foundation, Board members unanimously approved Janet Haley to replace Deedee Daniel as Executive Director when Daniel retires at the end of the year. Haley will only be the second Executive Director of the Community Foundation. Daniel became the first Executive Director shortly after the Community Foundation was formed in 1994. Haley will begin with the Community Foundation on September 2.

Haley comes to the Hendricks County Community Foundation from the state’s largest community foundation, Central Indiana Community Foundation, where she worked as CFO for nine years and most recently as an Investment Analyst. Before joining CICF, Haley was a CPA for Birk Gross Bell & Coulter. Haley currently serves as a Trustee for the Plainfield Guilford Township Public Library and a member of the Investment Committee for Girl’s Inc. She is a member of the class of 2004 of Leadership Hendricks County, and is active with Plainfield High School Red Pride Booster Club and St. Susanna Church. Janet and her husband, John, are lifelong residents of Plainfield. They have two daughters.

Although Daniel is retiring, the Board of Directors has talked with her about continuing to work with the Foundation as Director of Development on a limited base.

The Hendricks County Community Foundation manages an \$8 million collection of funds that are created by individuals, families, businesses and organizations for charitable purposes. In 2007, funds held at the Community Foundation awarded over \$475,000 in grants to charitable organizations and scholarships to students. The Community Foundation provides an easy, effective way for donors to make a lasting impact on Hendricks County.
