### **Vectren pledges financial support to Plainfield Youth Athletic Complex**

AVON, IND. – The future looks a little brighter for the construction of the Plainfield Youth Athletic Complex thanks to the Vectren Foundation. Vectren Energy operations supervisor Shane Alexander will present a \$20,000 check to Renea Whicker and John Wiggins from the Plainfield Youth Athletic Complex Fund Raising Committee and Janet Haley from the Hendricks County Community Foundation at the Plainfield Town Council meeting on Monday, December 22, 2008.

The planned athletic complex will serve all area youth from age 4 and up in soccer, football, baseball and youth cheerleading programs. It will contain two football fields, four standard baseball fields, six soccer fields and open spaces for activity. In addition, the new complex will include facilities and sports programming for those with disabilities.

“The ability to provide our community’s youth with a safe, state-of-the-art athletic facility is priceless,” said Whicker. “We appreciate Vectren’s support in making this dream for our children possible.”

The new complex is targeted to open in fall 2009 for soccer and in spring 2010 for all other sports.

We believe that this new complex will provide our youth with a safe place for them to grow and to develop into active adults that will enhance the quality of life in the communities we serve.”
