Sample Bequest Language

If you are considering a gift to the Hendricks County Community Foundation through your will, we recommend taking this with you when you meet with your attorney.

I give, devise and bequeath to the Hendricks County Community Foundation Inc., an Indiana nonprofit corporation [*the sum of/percentage of/residue of my estate*] to be used in furtherance of the charitable purposes of the Community Foundation as defined in and subject to the provisions of its Articles of Incorporation and By-Laws. This devise will be used to establish a component fund to be known as the [*insert name of fund*] Fund. I direct that the annual net income of the Fund be used for [*insert charitable purpose*] by the Foundation pursuant to its guidelines and criteria.

Jerry Hinds Indy Hoops Memorial Scholarship Fund

After Jerry Hinds' untimely death, Larry and Debbie Hendren wanted to do something to memorialize and celebrate Jerry's dedication to youth and the basketball program. Jerry started the Brownsburg Hoops program and the Indy Hoops 3rd grade program. Larry said, "Jerry was the biggest promoter and supporter of Indy Hoops Basketball." The Hendrens initiated a memorial fund for their friend and colleague Jerry Hinds.

Most scholarships are awarded to graduating seniors, however, this one is awarded to a sixth-grade basketball player who has participated in the Indy Hoops program as a fourth, fifth and sixth-grader. A student can be nominated by his coach, director, or team and must have displayed excellent sportsmanship



qualities. He must complete an essay telling what positive impact playing basketball has had on his life. After winning this scholarship, it is the responsibility of the student to maintain good grades so that he can enroll in college while continuing his good sportsmanship and positive attitude. When the student is enrolled in college, he will notify the Hendricks County Community Foundation and will receive the \$1000 scholarship. What a great incentive for a student!

Planting the Seed Awards

The Hendricks County Community Foundation awarded its first Planting the Seed Awards at its Annual Dinner this spring. This award was established by the Annual Dinner committee in an effort to recognize those individuals that helped the Community Foundation plant seeds that led to significant gifts.

The recipients of this award were: Jerry Holifield, posthumously to Ben and Dorotha Anderson—accepted by their daughter-in-law Debbie Anderson, and Willis Parker. Jerry Holifield, as Superintendent of Plainfield Community School Corporation, was instrumental in placing the Pliny and Mildred Randall scholarship into the Community Foundation. The Randall Fund was the Community Foundation's first scholarship fund. Jerry and the school system understood that the Community Foundation was in the endowment and forever business.

Ben and Dorotha Anderson made the Community Foundation the permanent beneficiary of their Charitable Remainder Trust. This was the first deferred or planned gift given. The Ander-

sons enjoyed income for life and had the satisfaction of knowing, that when they both were gone, the rest of the trust would come to the Foundation to initiate their family fund. They believed this was a wonderful way to give back to their community.

The last award was given to Willis Parker for his significant contribution to the Community Foundation. He helped establish the county-wide organization, has continued to be involved with the Amo Alumni Association Fund, and helped Jackie Eggers leave a legacy to the community he loved.
