# 2021 Community **Enhancement Grantmaking**

In 2021, HCCF awarded over \$187,000 in Community Enhancement Grants to support organizations all across Hendricks County. Our Community Enhancement Funds are flexible, or unrestricted, funds that allow HCCF to respond to the greatest needs and opportunities in our community. Grants are made by our all-volunteer Program Committee and staff as directed and approved by the HCCF Board of Directors. The grants come from our unrestricted Community Enhancement funds, including the Deedee Daniel Opportunity Fund, the First Merchants Charitable Fund, the Directors Unrestricted Fund, and our 63 Family Legacy Funds.


