Hendricks County Community Foundation Awards a Grant of \$15,345 to Hendricks County Senior Services

The Hendricks County Community Foundation (HCCF) recently awarded Hendricks County Senior Services \$15,345 to purchase dehumidifiers for the HVAC system. The dehumidifiers will improve the comfort of guests, especially those who exercise at the Senior Center during the summer months. The grant was made from the Raths Family Fund, a Donor Advised Fund at HCCF.
