2025 Community Impact Grantmaking

In Round 1 of the 2025 Community Impact Grant program, HCCF awarded over **\$81,000** to support organizations across Hendricks County. These grants are powered by our **Community Enhancement Funds**, which are flexible, unrestricted funds allowing HCCF to address the community's most pressing needs and opportunities.

Our all-volunteer Program Committee and staff recommend grants, with final approval from the HCCF Board of Directors. Funding sources include the Deedee Daniel Opportunity Fund, the Lincoln Federal Charitable Foundation Unrestricted Fund, the Directors Unrestricted Fund, and our 68 Family Legacy Funds.
