Dear Friends

Thank you for making 2018 another remarkable year for your Community Foundation! We expanded our impact in Hendricks County in exciting ways, partnered with generous people and organizations to make our home a better place, and made effective grants to support a variety of charitable projects and programs in our community. Thank you to the donors who made our successful year possible.

The Community Foundation's assets saw substantial growth through gifts and grants of over \$2 million from generous people and organizations. This allowed the Board to approve grants and scholarships totaling almost \$600,000 to benefit a wide variety of Hendricks County citizens and area nonprofits in 2018. Our conservative investment stance helped us limit losses in a down market, with our endowed investment portfolio experiencing a loss of -5.67%.

Our unrestricted grantmaking for 2018 once again focused on partnering with our local nonprofits to build their institutional capacity to help them be as effective and efficient as possible. This played out in many exciting ways, including our monthly Nonprofit Learning Series, professional development and other capacity building grants, and our exciting volunteer job fair, Get Involved.

We were excited in October to learn of Lilly Endowment's new GIFT VII grant to community foundations statewide. GIFT VII has two parts: a matching phase and community leadership phase. In the Matching Grant, HCCF received \$1.1 M to match new gifts to our unrestricted funds. Our unrestricted funds – such as the Opportunity Fund and our Family Legacy Funds – are those flexible funds that we use to address needs and opportunities in our community today and tomorrow. The match under GIFT VII is \$2 to \$1, so a \$1,000 gift becomes \$3,000!

The second part of GIFT VII is the Community Leadership Grant, and it actually consists of two separate grants: a planning grant where we will receive \$100,000 in 2019, and an implementation grant where we will receive \$200,000 in 2020. Lilly Endowment is challenging us to step into a more prominent community leadership role and select an issue in our community to focus on over the next two years. You'll be hearing more about this as 2019 unfolds.

We are thankful for the continued support of long-time donors, our many volunteers, new friends of the Community Foundation, and our dedicated professional staff. Our Board is committed to realizing our vision of Hendricks County as a vibrant, giving community. Won't you join us today?

## Larry & Becky Paynter: Fighting Hunger One Meal at a Time





Larry Paynter has been in the restaurant business for over 38 years. Beginning at the "Coach & Horses" restaurant on Raceway Road, Larry is now the owner of "The Coachman" in Plainfield, which will celebrate its 30th anniversary this summer.

Larry has lived most of his life in Plainfield and is passionate

about giving back to the community that has given so much to him. He has been active in different community organizations for many years, including the Plainfield Chamber of Commerce, Visit Hendricks County, and the HCCF Board of Directors. Larry was also instrumental in helping raise \$100,000 through golf outings for the Jordan House Scholarship Fund at HCCF.

He and his wife of 36 years, Becky, vividly remember growing up poor and knowing hunger. As a boy, Larry didn't even realize his family was poor until he visited friends who had indoor plumbing and their own bedrooms. But his concept of poverty and hunger radically changed when Larry traveled overseas while serving in the military. He said, "You really haven't experienced hunger until you have been where I have been. In the Marine Corps, I traveled to Southeast Asia and there I saw real, raw hunger. I want to do my part to make sure that doesn't happen here. "

Larry and Becky are both passionate about taking on

hunger in Hendricks County. They donate every month to the Hendricks County Food Pantry Coalition Fund at HCCF, and just last month, they started a new fund, the "Larry and Becky Paynter Never Go Hungry Fund." This is a designated fund which will make grants every year to the Hendricks County Food Pantry Coalition (HCFPC). The Coalition enhances the efforts of Hendricks County food pantries to help meet basic nutritional needs of residents and to provide training and education to the affiliated pantries.

The Coalition currently supports 24 food pantries in Hendricks County, including 3 pet food pantries and 1 hygiene pantry. These member pantries serve over 65,000 individuals and distribute over 160,000 meals every year. Many people would be shocked to learn that one in ten Hendricks County residents (1 in 5 children) live in food insecure households, meaning they don't know where their next meal is coming from. HCFPC and the member pantries rely on generous donors like Larry and Becky to provide the funds needed to stock the pantries and ensure food insecure families can get the resources they need.

Larry and Becky have served their community for more than 35 years. They want to leave a legacy through their fund that will outlive them and continue their fight to end hunger in Hendricks County. "There is no excuse for hunger in this county," argues Larry. "We are very blessed, and we need to give so that people don't go hungry."

HCCF hosts a volunteer job fair, Get Involved, every year with the goal of matching volunteers who care about their community with the nonprofit organizations that need them.

Get Involved 2018 was truly a community event with 84 local nonprofits participating, and over 300 people in attendance. The local nonprofit exhibitors seeking volunteers and board members were able to connect with community members who share their passion and want to give back.



Get Involved 2018 was a success in bringing together over 140

nonprofit leaders face-to-face with philanthropic-minded people looking for their place to give back. One nonprofit exhibitor remarked, "This event was a HOME RUN! We had a great turnout for possible volunteers and will grow because of it!"

"This was a fantastic event! It was so impressive to see how many non-for-profit organizations serve our area. Thank you for providing this wonderful opportunity for us to connect with each other."

## Get 🛛 🐸 🖾 Involved



2018 marked the third year of the Community Foundation's Nonprofit Learning Series, providing free learning opportunities locally for nonprofits' staff, Board Members, and volunteers. Held monthly, the learning sessions allow networking among nonprofits as well as high-quality training from professionals in Central Indiana.

This year the sessions took three different approaches: webinar



viewings, classroom-style lectures, and panel discussions. The highlight of the year was a two-day course, "Fundraising for Small Nonprofits," presented by the IUPUI Lilly Family School for Philanthropy. HCCF was excited to give our nonprofits this opportunity to receive professional level training here in Hendricks County at a significantly reduced cost. Other sessions for the year included topics like "How to Find & Recruit Your Volunteer Dream Team," "Digital Marketing for Nonprofits," and "Fundraising Evaluation." For 2018, sessions earned a rating of 4.8 out of 5 and hosted 109 unique individuals.

HCCF also hosted quarterly Nonprofit Networking events powered by Hendricks Power Cooperative which were free to participants. These networking events build community, allowing nonprofits the opportunity to get to know each other both personally and professionally. 




