## **HCCF Awards Grants to the Avon-Washington Township Library**

The Community Foundation recently awarded two grants to the Avon-Washington Township Library to support operations. The first grant, in the amount of \$293, will support the maintenance of the Huron Heritage Room's Avon High School yearbook collection, while the second grant, in the amount of \$4258, will support programs and equipment that may not be covered by the library's Operating Fund.

The Avon High School yearbook collection is an important part of the library's local history resources, providing a glimpse into the lives and experiences of past generations of students in the area. The grant will enable the library to carry out essential preservation work on the collection and expand the current collection in support of preserving local history.
