This month, we're thrilled to spotlight the Electric Plus Cares Fund (see more below), created last October in partnership with Electric Plus to grow their employee-led giving program. What began as a heartfelt holiday effort to support families in need has now grown into a formal fund that has granted nearly \$60,000 in its first year - supporting communities in Hendricks County, Bloomington, and Lafayette.

This kind of custom fund isn't just good for the community - it's good for the company, too. When businesses partner with HCCF, they can engage employees, streamline giving, and maximize impact. Electric Plus matched employee contributions dollar-for-dollar to power their fund - and while donor-advised funds like this aren't eligible for our current <u>Stronger Together</u> match, they serve as a shining example of the kind of generosity that makes our work possible.

And speaking of impact: thanks to a generous anonymous donor along with Lilly Endowment, gifts to unrestricted Community Enhancement Funds now receive a \$3 to \$1 match. That means every dollar you give becomes four - quadrupling the good we can do together through local grants.
